Enhanced Screening

- Enhanced Accessible Property Screening
 - Threat worldwide; 280 airports/100 countries; piloted at 10 US airports
 - What does this mean for you
 - Reduce clutter; focused bag check
 - ...but I'm Pre-Check...
- Canine Enhanced Screening
 - In the queuing line

Real ID

- Background: 2005; sets tougher security standards
- Avoid travel problems
- Prepare for the checkpoint:
 - Ensure you have an acceptable ID and boarding pass ready
 - https://www.tsa.gov/travel/security-screening/identification
- Bottom line: must be in compliance or not accepted
- California extended thru October 10, 2018
- https://www.dhs.gov/real-id-public-faqs
- Hard cut off date is October 1, 2020; all states compliant

TSA Preê

- What: expedited screening, shoes, light outerwear/belt, laptop in case and 3-1-1 compliant liquids/gels in a carry-on. \$85 for a five-year membership
- Currently 42 airlines who participate in the TSA Preê

- September 2017, 96% of TSA Preè passengers waited less than 5 min
- Over 5 million are already taking advantage of TSA Pre√[®]

Security Protocol

- What can I do;
- Arrive early; avoid wait-time
- Documents ready at TDC; check travel documents
- Ready to Divest; prepare for EAPS
 - To TSA Pre√® or not to TSA Pre√®
 - Officers are required to resolve any/all alarm(s)
